THE BIG RED Barrel Project

A program of the Livingston County Community Alliance

Educate. Collect. Dispose.

- *Sharps need to be in a heavy plastic container (i.e. Red “Sharp” Box or empty plastic laundry detergent jug sealed with tape).
- Sharp collection is open to residents. Businesses and medical facilities are not allowed to dispose of sharps at this event.
- Liquid medications accepted only if you first stuff a zip-lock plastic bag with enough paper towels to absorb all the liquid.
- Use separate bags for each liquid medication.
